The meeting was called to order by Vice President Theresa Chaney-Huggett at 6:57pm.

Local businesses and organizations as well as regional businesses help keep the Library's expenses down and still allow outstanding programs for the patrons to enjoy. July and August are typically the lowest months for income but tax money will begin coming in during September. Chairman Lark made a motion to pay bills in the amount of \$90,130. 72. All present voted yes.

Director's Report: Library Director Angela Semifero reported that a new computer system has been installed. As a result there has been extra work for the technical staff. A snack cart has been made available for the after school crowd. Prices are generally one dollar or less. The school will begin supplying additional healthy snacks on September 17<sup>th</sup>. The John Bellairs walking tours have been filling up fast. There has been a lot of good press not only locally but regionally as well. Ben Lark asked if the Library had emergency plans in place. Both Nate Palmer and Director Semifero responded that they had plans for different scenarios.

Chelsea Johnson was introduced by Angela. Chelsea has been with the Library for six years. Her specialty, and also her passion, is genealogy. The Library has many sources available- directories, plat maps, cemetery records etc. She is also willing to assist patrons with individual research. All are free.
