

**Afterschool Behavior Expectations
2019-20 School Year**

1. Only one person is allowed at each computer.
2. Inappropriate behavior at/on the computers (e.g. you are being too loud, looking at inappropriate material, harassing others through online social media and/or game sites, attempting to download software or log in to the server, or inappropriately shutting down a computer), may result in loss of computer privileges.
3. No rocking back and forth on two legs of the chairs.
4. Only four people may be seated at a table. Only one person should use one seat at a time.
5. Bad language, loudness, teasing, bullying, roughhousing, and rudeness will not be tolerated. You will be asked to leave for the day if this occurs.
6. The library is not responsible for your belongings. This includes: backpacks, homework, musical instruments, school projects, etc.
7. You are welcome to leave coats and bags by the restrooms, but items must not block access to the Meeting Room or restrooms. Library staff will not hold or watch your belongings.
8. If you leave the building, you are expected to take all belongings with you.
9. Food is to be eaten outside only, unless it is part of a program and then only in designated areas.
10. Covered beverages are allowed in the library except at the computer stations. Open containers must be taken outside the library. Cans with open tabs are not considered covered and are not allowed.
11. Cell phone calls must be taken to the lobby or outside the library.
12. Hanging out or waiting for rides in the lobby is not allowed. You may wait inside or outside the building.
13. You may use the phone at the Help Desk to call a parent or guardian to arrange a ride home or to let a parent or guardian know you are at the library. Phone calls for other purposes are not allowed.
14. You must follow the Patron Code of Conduct; anyone not using the library for its designated purpose will be asked to leave for the day. These activities include: studying, reading a book or magazine, using a computer, attending a library program, quietly playing a board game, or working on coloring pages/activity sheets.
15. The Early Literacy Area is reserved for children ages 0-10 and their caregivers.
16. If behavior during a library program is inappropriate (e.g. you are being too loud, not listening or following directions or not participating), staff may ask you to leave for the day.
17. Be respectful of library staff and other library visitors.
