Changes Coming to Library Ancestry & eBook Access

Don't delay: through the end of 2021, Ancestry Library Edition is available to access at home from a link on the library homepage. Beginning in Jan., free access will continue to be available inside the library's physical building.

If you have been using the mobile app OverDrive to borrow free eBooks, eAudioBooks, & eMagazines available through Woodlands Downloadable Library, now is the time to upgrade to the Libby app. Libby is the newest app from OverDrive, inspired by library and user feedback and designed to get people reading as quickly and seamlessly as possible. OverDrive has announced that they will be removing the OverDrive app from the Apple App Store, Google Play, and Microsoft Store in Feb. 2022; those who already have it installed will be able to continue using it. However, it is not clear how long support will be available. Thus, Marshall District Library encourages readers to migrate to the Libby app in order to have continuous, uninterrupted access to our OverDrive materials. You can also visit or call to make an appointment for one-on-one tech assistance. Library staff can help you make the transition from the OverDrive app to the Libby app. Access to the digital collection will remain available online at https://woodlands.overdrive.com/.

Due to the current recommendations from the Calhoun County Health Department, masks are recommended though not required when visiting the library. At this time, there is no after school programming planned. Curbside pick-up services remain available.
